
#### Create or Update Your Resume

Utilize free online resume builder tools such as Skills First or Illinois JobLink.

Local Illinois workNet American Job Centers also offer in-person resources. Centers offer free access to a resource room that is open to the public on a self-service basis. Resources are available to assist job seekers with building a resume, general career exploration, and job search.

#### **Unemployment Insurance Information**

Unemployment insurance is an IDES state-operated program designed to partially replace lost wages when you are out of work. It is for an emergency when you are temporarily or permanently out of a job, or if you work less than full time because of lack of work. If you meet the eligibility requirements of the law, you will have some income while you are looking for a job, up to a maximum of 26 full weeks in a one-year period. How to Submit a UI Claim





### **Dislocated Worker Surveys**

#### **Old Method**

- Distribute paper surveys
- Hand-count results
- Maintain paper files
- Multiple excel sheets
- No standardized survey

#### **New Method**

- Custom company pages
- Custom short URL
- Guided online survey
- Instant self-referrals
- Tracking system for staff
- Standardized survey


