



Dislocated Worker Surveys

Old Method

- Distribute paper surveys
- Hand-count results
- Maintain paper files
- Multiple excel sheets
- No standardized survey

New Method

- Custom company pages
- Custom short URL
- Guided online survey
- Instant self-referrals
- Tracking system for staff
- Standardized survey

Data in IEBS (1980 – 2024)

- 8,233 total events
- 5,397 official notices
- 894 trade events
- 783,985 reported layoffs
- 9,659 reported workshops

- All associated documentation
- Industry information (NAICS)
- FEIN / UI Account numbers

- #3. October 2020 – 10,524

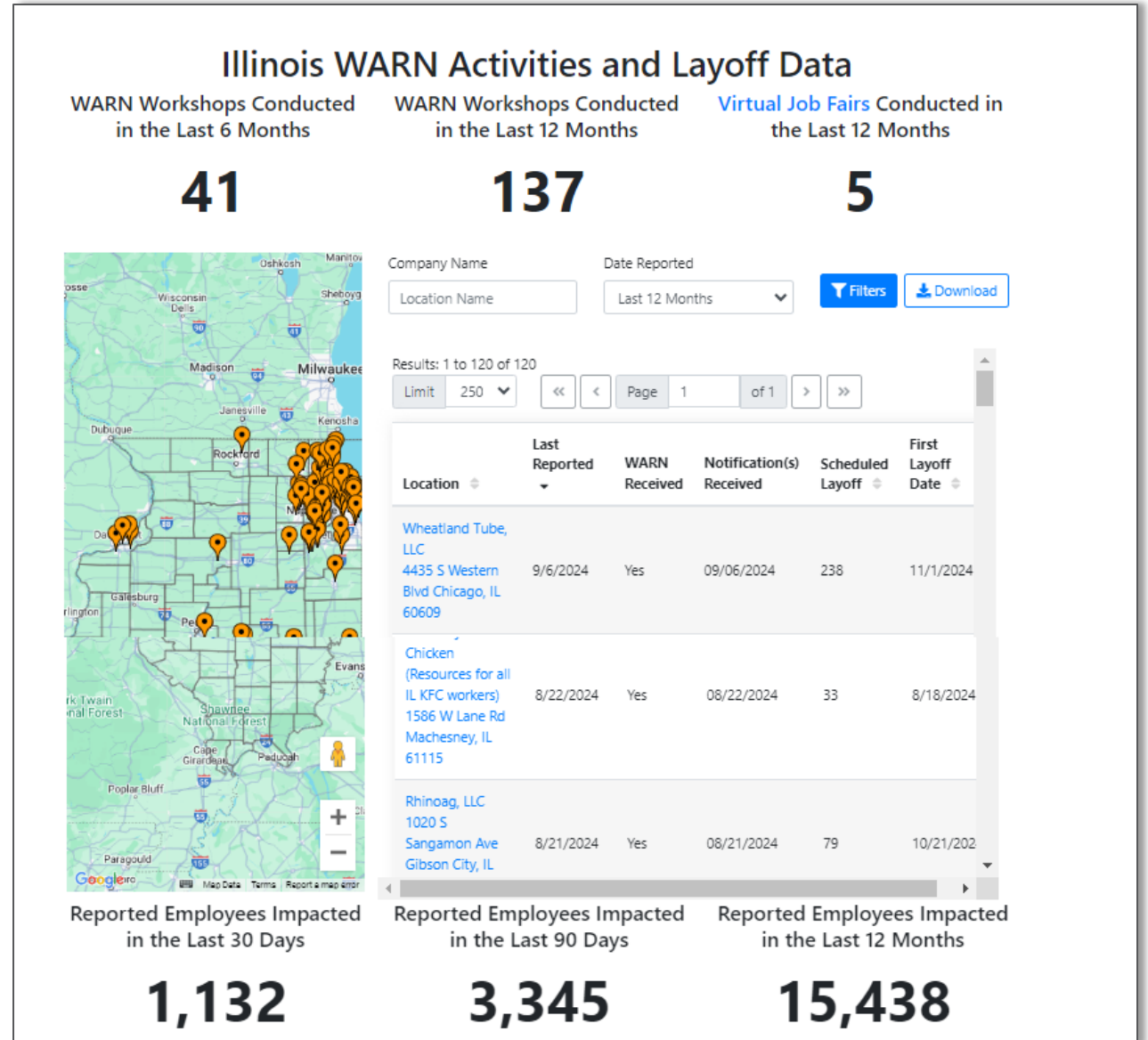
