








# Why create a Dictionary?



- Practitioners in the field expressed a need for greater clarity around pathways policy and strategy after ~10 years of work in different sectors
- Work was underway to adopt a unified Career Pathways definition for Illinois
- Many terms being used across different federal and state funding streams without alignment
- Desire to foster greater collaboration across State agencies
- There was nothing like it around!



### How was the Dictionary developed?

Unified definition of Career Pathways drafted &

adopted

Agency partners, Standing committees, and key stakeholders clarified and provided feedback on terms and definitions

Workforce Readiness through Apprenticeships & Pathways (WRAP) Committee of the Governor's Cabinet for Children & Families reviewed, discussed, approved final definitions for inclusion

Complete Dictionary published November 2018



# **Dictionary Overview**

### **Core Goal & Organization**

Provides a unified State resource that includes the adopted definition of Career Pathways and related terms/concepts.

Organized by:

- <u>Policy Context</u>: history, relevant policy examples/frameworks, agencies involved, etc.
- <u>Definitions</u>: statutory where possible (from State and federal legislation), otherwise developed based on best practice research & discussion across agencies
- <u>Implementation Guidance</u>: provides more detailed guidance in terms of what effective practices for implementing components can look like

### How were terms selected?

- The term pertains to or deeply impacts multiple programs across State agencies; and/or,
- The term applies to programming with funding from multiple federal agencies (e.g., WIOA-funded programming).



### What's happened since?

- Shared extensively throughout Illinois via agency websites, word-of-mouth, professional development opportunities, conferences, etc.
- Highlighted by multiple national partners as an innovative policy resource
- Utilized by practitioners across Illinois to inform college and career pathway system implementation work
  - Program design and brainstorming
  - PD and training for administrators and staff
  - Grant writing
  - Guidance for implementation of CCRI, PaCE and CCPE
  - Presentation planning

## **Illinois Career Pathways Dictionary Updates**

#### Why?

- It has been five years since the initial publication of the dictionary.
- To meet and support implementation and scaling needs that have arisen both naturally and through legislative action.
- To reflect evolving best practices

#### What will be the end result?

- An interactive web-based resource with short printable documents integrated throughout
- Updates to Work-Based learning and continuum elements definition
- Updating definitions and adding terms to reflect what is happening in the field

#### When?

• Aiming to publish by summer 2023



### Process


- Convened a group of representatives from DCEO, IDES, ISAC, ICCB, and ISBE for a series of meetings.
- Conducted a survey to gain a deeper understanding of the dictionary's relevance and use in the field.
- We have been making and reviewing changes to content as it emerges.
- Plans to build out website







- Circulated to a range of stakeholders:Illinois Education and Career Success ٠
  - Network
  - College and Career Access Persistence and Success (CCAPS) Illinois Workforce Innovation Board (IWIB) Illinois Workforce Partnership (IWP)
- 211 responses received •
- Themes that emerged ٠
  - Questions about how the dictionary intersects with recent policy changes
  - Clarification on Early College Credit •
  - Distinction between Program of Study and • Career Pathway
  - Desire for implementation guidance •
  - Interest in a more interactive dictionary and • links to resources
  - May be helpful to offer simpler language to use with students and families

# **Identified Updates**

### **New Definitions**

- Pre-Apprenticeship
  - The IWIB developed a more comprehensive definition in 2022.
- Integrated Career and Academic Preparation System (ICAPS)
  - The definition in the previous version was no longer accurate.
- Program of Study
  - This term was previously in an appendix. Prompted by survey responses and further discussion, it was determined more clarification was necessary.

### **New Terms**

- Incumbent Worker
  - Growing need for a common definition
- Early College Credit
  - Survey results suggested this was a common area of confusion.
- Dual Enrollment
- Articulated Credit
- Competency-Based Education
  - Increasing level of work happening around the state.
